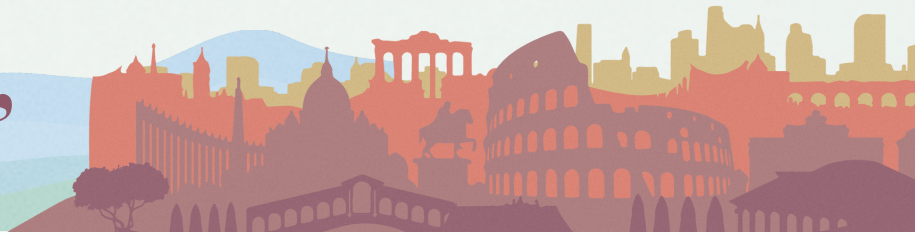


THE MAN, THE MESSAGE, THE MISSION

Discussion Questions

1. What stood out to you from the sermon? What did the Holy Spirit highlight to you?
2. Why do you think the book of Romans has had such an outsized impact throughout the history of the church?
3. For those who have read Romans before, what part of the letter are you looking forward to getting to in this series? Is there any part you're nervous about? Why?
4. How did you answer the "what is the gospel" question during the sermon? What did you make of the statement "the gospel is for you but it's not about you"?
5. Where in your life would you love to see something change (like Paul changed so radically)? Where do you want to experience more of the obedience that flows from faith? (v. 5)
6. What's your plan to really engage with the book of Romans this year?

After spending some time discussing these things, pray for each other.
