Discussion Questions

- 1. What stood out to you from the sermon? What did the Holy Spirit highlight to you?
- 2.In this message, we covered a lot of important theological terms: righteousness/unrighteousness, glory, worship, and the passive wrath of God. How would you define each of these in a non-churchy way? (using everyday language that anyone would understand)
- 3. What have you been revolving your life around lately? Is there anything you've been giving too much weight to?
- 4. What's the problem with worshiping created things rather than our creator (v. 25)? Why is this exchange so tragic?
- 5. Have you ever heard of the passive wrath of God before? What did you make of this part of the sermon?
- 6. How does this chapter help you make sense of the things we're seeing in the world around us today? Of your own life?
- 7. How does the gospel answer the problem Paul is outlining in these verses? How is Jesus good news for those of us who are lost in the dissatisfaction of misplaced worship?

After spending some time discussing these things, spend some time praying for each other.
